
I have also enclosed flyers for some upcoming cattle meetings and educational opportunities.

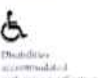

Receipts for vaccines, dewormer, and mineral supplement analysis tag **MUST** be attached to certification form and returned to Daviess County Extension Office by November 27, 2024.

GREEN RIVER CPH60 — REQUIREMENTS

- Owned by seller a minimum of 60 days.
- Weaned a minimum of 60 days.
- Trained to eat feed from a bunk and drink water from a trough.
(Do not overfeed; fleshy calves should be avoided, and are likely to be discounted.)
- Dehorned and healed. Visible Horns or Scurs will be graded as outs.
- Males castrated and healed (Knife castration is strongly recommended.)
Late castrated calves may be graded as outs.
- Treated for grubs and lice.
- Dewormed with an endectocide - **Dectomax or Long Range** no more than 60 days before the sale.
- Vaccinated for Pasturella and Clostridia (7-way) - **One Shot Ultra 7** - subcutaneously in the neck according to product label.
- Vaccinated and boosted for IBR, PI₃, BVD, and BRSV - **Cattle Master or Bovishield Gold 5** - (Booster injection for IBR, BVD, & PI₃ must be modified live vaccine, and BRSV may be killed or MLV.)
- All vaccines must be administered no more than 90 days and no less than 14 days prior to sale date. All processing recorded on body map and chart on CPH certificate.
- Identified with official Kentucky CPH tag.
- Heifers are guaranteed open at time of sale and steers are guaranteed not to be bulls!** Seller agrees to reimburse buyer \$200.00 for pregnant heifers or intact bulls. All claims will be properly verified by a veterinarian within four (4) months of sale.
- Mineral supplement must contain a minimum of 1400 ppm copper (no copper oxide), 26 ppm selenium, 3000 ppm zinc, 3000 ppm manganese, and a salt content of 18-25%.
- Kentuckiana Livestock marketing fee will be 3% commission of your total sale value.
- \$2.00/head consignment fee will be withheld by Kentuckiana on behalf of the Green River Area CPH Sale Committee.

EXTENDED WEANING OPTIONS

(Calves weaned a minimum of 90 days before sale)

- Same requirements as above except that backgrounded cattle do not have to be revaccinated prior to sale, provided they were vaccinated and boosted according to label guideline time limits for the diseases listed above in item 9 and item 7.
- Grub and lice treatment according to label recommendations for time of year.

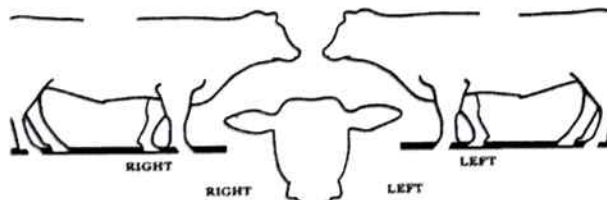
