The Henderson County Conservation District also works jointly and directly with a USDA Natural Resources Conservation Services (NRCS) team who are also housed at the same location.

The State Cost Share Program is available through the Henderson County Conservation District. This program helps landowners address existing soil erosion, water quality, and other environmental problems associated with their farming or woodland operation.

Keep in mind if any landowners are interested in the State Cost Share Program, you can sign up on a continuous year-round basis but there is a cut-off period of October 1, 2025, for landowners to submit applications for consideration for the 2026 eligibility year; applications are available at our office.

Pumpkin Apple Muffins

1 ½ cups all-purpose flour	1 ½ teaspoon ground	1 ½ cups fresh pureed pumpkin
1 ¼ cups whole-wheat flour	ginger	¾ cup canola oil
1 ¼ teaspoons baking soda	½ teaspoon ground nutmeg	2 cups Granny Smith apples, finely chopped
½ teaspoon salt	1 ¼ cups honey	
1 ½ teaspoons ground cinnamon	2 large eggs	

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. In a large bowl, **combine** flours, baking soda, salt and spices. In a small bowl, **combine** honey, eggs, pumpkin and oil; **stir** into dry ingredients just until moistened. **Fold** in apples. **Fill** greased or paper lined muffin cups, two-thirds full. **Bake** for 25 to 30 minutes or until muffins test done. **Cool** for 10 minutes before removing from pan.

Note: Can substitute two cups granulated sugar for honey, decrease baking soda by ¼ teaspoon and increase oven temperature to 350 degrees F.

Yield: 18 muffins

Nutritional Analysis: 200 calories, 7 g fat, 0.5 g saturated fat, 35 mg cholesterol, 160 mg sodium, 35 g carbohydrate, 2 g fiber, 20 g sugar, 3 g protein
